THE COLOR OF THE MANIPLE, STOLE, AND CHASUBLE IS CHANGED ACCORDING TO THE FEAST OR MASS.


WHITE (PURITY): ON FEASTS OF OUR LORD, OUR LADY, AND SAINTS WHO WERE NOT MARTYRS.

BLACK (SORROW): FOR GOOD FRIDAY AND MASSES FOR THE DEAD.


GREEN(HOPE): FOR DAYS WHEN NONE

IS PRESCRIBED.










































TWO MASSES IN ONE **KNOW YOUR MASS**

TO: RECEIVE INSTRUCTION.


2. THE MASS OF THE FAITHFUL

FOR:


CATHOLICS ONLY,


TO: RE-OFFER THE SACRIFICE OF THE CROSS, AND RECEIVE OUR LORD

STRENGTH. WHY HAST THOU FORSAKEN ME? AND WHY DO I GO ABOUT IN SADNESS, WHILE THE ENEMY
AFFLICTS ME?






PRIEST: I WILL GO TO THE ALTAR OF GOD.



THE PRIEST EXPRESSES SORROW FOR HIS OWN SINS FIRST.

WHILE HE IS DOING THIS, SAY A PRAYER FOR THE PRIEST WHO IS SAYING THE MASS. SINCE THE PRIEST IS YOUR REPRESENTATIVE BEFORE GOD, YOU SHOULD PRAY FOR HIM OFTEN.

PRIEST: O LORD, HEAR MY PRAYER.


SERVER: AND LET MY CRY COME UNTO THEE.

PRIEST: THE LORD BE WITH YOU. SERVER: AND WITH THY SPIRIT.


THE PRAYERS AT THE FOOT OF THE ALTAR ARE THE "PRIVATE" PRAYERS OF THE PRIEST AND THE PEOPLE PREPARING THEM FOR THEIR PART IN THE MASS.

IF THE MASS IS A HIGH MASS, THE CHOIR WILL HAVE BEEN SINGING THE "PUBLIC" PREPARATION DURING THIS TIME.


THIS PUBLIC PREPARATION IS CALLED THE "INTROIT."



BEFORE RECITING THE INTROIT HIMSELF, THE PRIEST GOES UP TO THE ALTAR, ONCE MORE ASKS PARDON FOR HIS SINS, AND KISSES THE ALTAR STONE.



THE ALTAR, AND ESPECIALLY THE ALTAR STONE, REPRESENTS THE BODY OF CHRIST. HENCE IT IS KISSED REVER-ENTLY.



HAVING PROCEEDED TO THE EPISTLE SIDE OF THE ALTAR, THE PRIEST STANDS BEFORE THE MISSAL AND BLESSES HIMSELF. THE PRIEST NOW READS THE INTROIT, THE FIRST VARIABLE PART OF THE MASS. AT HIGH MASS THE INTROIT IS ALSO SUNG BY THE CHOIR.




NOTICE THE PRIEST

BOWS HIS HEAD WHENEVER
HE SAYS: "GLORY BE TO THE
FATHER, ETC."

VERY OFTEN THE INTROIT IS TAKEN FROM PART OF THE PSALMS. LONG AGO THE WHOLE PSALM WAS SUNG IN A PROCESSION TO THE ALTAR.

NOW ONLY PART OF THE PSALM OR SOME OTHER SHORT VERSE IS USED. BUT IT STILL SHOWS THE PROPER NATURE OF THE DAY'S PARTICULAR FEAST. HENCE IT IS CALLED PART OF THE PROPER OF THE MASS AND CHANGES WITH EACH FEAST.

KNOW YOUR MASS CHAPTER FOUR:



WE ARE NOW READY TO TAKE THE FIRST STEP IN THE PART OF THE MASS OF THE CATECHU-MENS WHERE WE TALK TO GOD.

THE FIRST STEP IS THE KYRIE. ALL THE OTHER MASS PRAYERS ARE IN LATIN. THIS PRAYER IS IN GREEK, WHICH IS ONE OF THE OLDEST LANGUAGES IN WHICH MASS HAS BEEN OFFERED.

PRIEST: LORD, HAVE MERCY ON US. --

PRIEST: CHRIST, HAVE MERCY ON US. SERVER: CHRIST, HAVE MERCY ON US.

PRIEST: LORD, HAVE MERCY ON US.

SERVER: LORD, HAVE MERCY ON US. -PRIEST: LORD, HAVE MERCY ON US. - FATHER

WE ASK EACH PERSON OF THE TRINITY THREE TIMES TO FORGIVE US OUR SINS.





HE DOES THIS WHENEVER HE WANTS TO CALL THEIR ATTENTION TO A VERY SPECIAL PART OF THE MASS.





HAVING RETURNED TO THE EPISTLE SIDE THE PRIEST BOWS TOWARD THE CRUCIFIX AND SAYS: "LET US PRAY."

THE SPECIAL ACTION THIS TIME IS THE COLLECTS-OR ORATIONS-THE PRAYERS OF PETITION.

THE PRIEST PRAYS WITH ARMS OUTSTRETCHED AS MOSES PRAYED WHEN HE WANTED GOD TO HELP THE ISRAELITES IN BATTLE.




IN EVERY COLLECT WE ASK GOD THE FATHER FOR SOME FAVOR THROUGH THE SON IN UNION WITH THE THREE DIVINE PERSONS AGAIN!

SOME MASSES HAVE ONE COLLECT. OTHERS HAVE SEVERAL. THE COLLECTS CHANGE WITH EACH MASS.

KNOW YOUR MASS CHAPTER FIVE:

NOW THAT WE HAVE TALKED TO GOD, HE SPEAKS TO US. NOTICE HOW THE TRINITY IS REPRESENTED HERE TOO.






OH, THE DEPTH OF THE RICHES OF THE WISDOM AND OF THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD! HOW INCOMPREHENSIBLE ARE HIS JUDG-MENTS AND HOW UNSEARCHABLE HIS WAYS! FOR WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, OR WHO HAS BEEN HIS COUNCILLOR? OR WHO HAS FIRST GIVEN TO HIM, THAT RECOMPENSE SHOULD BE MADE HIM? FOR FROM HIM AND THROUGH HIM AND UNTO HIM ARE ALL THINGS. TO HIM BE GLORY FOREVER.

THE EPISTLE IS READ RIGHT AFTER THE COLLECTS.

YOU MAY SIT DOWN HERE.




MANY EPISTLES ARE TAKEN FROM THE LETTERS OF SAINT PAUL, BUT OTHERS ARE CHOSEN FROM THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES, THE APOCALYPSE OF SAINT JOHN, THE LETTERS OF OTHER APOSTLES, OR THE OLD TESTAMENT.

THE EPISTLE IS CHOSEN TO FIT THE FEAST OR OCCASION.



ALTHOUGH IT IS POSSIBLE TO HAVE MORE THAN ONE EPISTLE AT A MASS, ONLY A FEW MASSES DURING THE YEAR HAVE MORE THAN ONE.

WHEN THE EPISTLE IS FINISHED, THE PRIEST, BY EXTENDING HIS LEFT HAND ON THE ALTAR, SIGNALS THE ALTAR BOY, WHO THANKS GOD FOR THE LESSONS WE HAVE LEARNED.




ALLELUIA, ALLELUIA, BLESSED ART THOU, O LORD GOD OF OUR FATHERS, AND WORTHY OF PRAISE FOR EVER. ALLELUIA.

AS THE SERVER COMES TO GET THE MISSAL THE PRIEST READS SEVERAL SHORT PRAYERS.

THESE PRAYERS EXPRESS OUR JOY AT HAVING CHRIST TEACH US. HENCE AT HIGH MASS THESE PRAYERS ARE SUNG.

LIKE THE EPISTLE, THESE PRAYERS ALSO CHANGE WITH THE FEAST.



THE PRAYERS ARE:

THE GRADUAL: CALLED GRADUAL BECAUSE THE OLD CANTORS USED TO STAND ON THE ALTAR STEPS WHEN THEY SANG.


THE ALLELUIA: A VERY SHORT SONG OF PRAISE. "ALLELUIA" IS A HEBREW WORD MEANING "PRAISE GOD."

THE TRACT: A LONGER, LESS JOYFUL PRAYER WHICH TAKES THE PLACE OF THE ALLELUIA DURING SAD OR PENITENTIAL TIMES.

ON CERTAIN FEASTS A LONG POEM IS ADDED TO THE ALLELUIA OR TRACT. THIS IS CALLED THE SEQUENCE.



AFTER THESE PRAYERS THE MISSAL IS TAKEN TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE ALTAR, AND THE PRIEST SAYS A SPECIAL PRAYER ASKING GOD TO HELP HIM READ THE GOSPEL WORTHILY.




YOU STAND FOR THE GOSPEL.

WE STAND DURING THE GOSPEL OUT OF REVERENCE FOR CHRIST'S WORDS

THE GOSPEL IS READ ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE ALTAR. THE RIGHT SIDE IS THE PLACE OF HONOR.


TO BEGIN THE GOSPEL THE PRIEST SIGNS HIMSELF WITH THE CROSS ON HIS FOREHEAD, LIPS, AND HEART. YOU DO IT TOO:











THE GOSPEL IS ALWAYS FROM ONE OF THE FOUR BIOGRA-PHERS OF CHRIST: MATTHEW, MARK, LUKE, OR JOHN, IT, TOO, CHANGES WITH THE FEAST.

AT THE END, THE PRIEST KISSES THE BOOK OUT OF REVERENCE.

ON SUNDAYS THE PRIEST USUALLY GIVES A SERMON OR INSTRUCTION AFTER THE GOSPEL.

THE SERMON IS A REAL PART OF THE MASS. IT IS AN IMPORTANT WAY IN WHICH GOD SPEAKS TO US.

BEFORE THE SERMON THE PRIEST USUALLY READS THE GOSPEL AGAIN IN OUR OWN LANGUAGE.

SIT DOWN NOW.

DURING THE SERMON YOU SHOULD BE AS QUIET AS YOU CAN AND PAY VERY CLOSE ATTENTION.

KNOW YOUR MASS CHAPTER SIX:

I BELIEVE IN ONE GOD, THE FATHER ALMIGHTY, MAKER OF HEAVEN AND EARTH,
AND OF ALL THINGS VISIBLE AND INVISIBLE. AND IN ONE LORD, JESUS CHRIST,
THE ONLY-BEGOTTEN SON OF GOD, BORN
OF THE FATHER BEFORE ALL AGES. GOD
OF GOD, LIGHT OF LIGHT, TRUE GOD OF
TRUE GOD. BEGOTTEN, NOT MADE; OF
ONE BEING WITH THE FATHER: BY
WHOM ALL THINGS
WERE MADE. WHO
FOR US MEN, AND
FOR OUR SALVATION CAME DOWN
FROM HEAVEN.

AND WAS MADE FLESH BY THE HOLY GHOST, OF THE VIRGIN MARY:

ON SUNDAYS AND IMPORTANT FEAST DAYS THE PRIEST RECITES THE CREED AS SOON AS HE RETURNS TO THE ALTAR. IT IS THE NICENE CREED.

THE CREED EXPRESSES THE CHIEF THINGS A CATHOLIC MUST BELIEVE. IT IS OUR ACT OF FAITH IN THE THINGS WE HAVE LEARNED IN THE EPISTLE, GOSPEL AND SERMON.

HENCE IT IS AN EXCELLENT PREPARATION FOR THE MASS OF THE FAITHFUL. IT IS LIKE A PASSWORD LETTING US INTO THE GREAT MYSTERY OF THE MASS.


THE MASS OF THE FAITHFUL MEANS THE MASS OF THOSE WHO BELIEVE.

BELIEVE WHAT?

BELIEVE EVERYTHING IN THE CREED.

AT THE WORDS WHICH REMIND US OF THE MOMENT WHEN JESUS BECAME MAN WE GENUFLECT IN ADDRATION. (AT HIGH MASS, WHEN THE CREED IS SUNG, WE KNEEL.)





NOTICE HOW THE CREED IS DIVIDED INTO WHAT WE BELIEVE CONCERNING EACH OF THE THREE PERSONS OP THE TRINITY - WITH THE DOCTRINES OF THE CHURCH, BAPTISM, RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD AND ETERNAL LIFE ADDED AT THE END.


WITH THE CLOSE OF THE CREED (OR IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE GOSPEL IN MASSES WHERE THERE IS NO CREED) WE HAVE CROSSED THE BRIDGE THAT LEADS FROM THE MASS OF THE CATECHUMENS TO THE MASS OF THE FAITHFUL.





THE MASS OF THE FAITH-FUL BEGINS BY THE PRIEST'S CALLING THE PEOPLE TO ATTENTION IN THE USUAL WAY.

YOU MAY SIT DOWN NOW.

IN THE EARLY DAYS OF THE CHURCH ALL PUBLIC SINNERS AND THOSE WHO WERE NOT CATHOLICS HAD TO LEAVE THE CHURCH AT THIS POINT.












YEARS AGO THE OFFERTORY BEGAN WITH A PROCESSION DURING WHICH A SPECIAL PSALM WAS SUNG AS GIFTS WERE BROUGHT TO THE ALTAR.



TODAY WE NO LONGER HAVE THE PROCESSION, SO THE PRIEST READS ONLY A SHORT PRAYER OR VERSE OF THE PSALM. THIS IS CALLED THE OFFERTORY VERSE.

THE OFFERTORY VERSE CHANGES WITH THE FEAST IT IS SUNG BY THE CHOIR AT HIGH MASS.

IN MANY CHURCHES THE BELL IS RUNG WHEN THE PRIEST UNCOVERS THE CHALICE TO REMIND THE PEOPLE THAT A MOST IMPORTANT PART OF THE MASS IS BEGINNING.



ACCEPT, O HOLY FATHER, ALMIGHTY AND ETERNAL GOD, THIS SPOTLESS HOST, WHICH I, THY UNWORTHY SERVANT, OFFER UNTO THEE, MY LIVING AND TRUE GOD, TO ATONE FOR MY NUMBERLESS SINS, OFFENS-ES, AND NEGLIGENCES; ON BEHALF OF ALL HERE PRESENT AND LIKE-WISE FOR ALL FAITHFUL CHRISTIANS LIVING AND DEAD, THAT IT MAY PROFIT ME AND THEM AS A MEANS OF SAL-VATION UNTO LIFE EVER-LASTING. AMEN.



PUTTING THE CHALICE ASIDE, THE PRIEST FIRST OFFERS THE BREAD.



BREAD IS ALSO A SYMBOL OF CHRIST.

BREAD = NOURISHMENT= LIFE

WHEN WE OFFER THE HOST WITH THE PRIEST, WE LOOK FORWARD TO OUR OFFERING OF JESUS CHRIST, BECAUSE THE BREAD WILL BECOME THE BODY OF CHRIST AT THE CONSECRATION.







WHEN THE PRIEST IS GOING TO CONSECRATE HOSTS FOR THE PEOPLE (IF THERE ARE NOT ENOUGH ALREADY CONSECRATED IN THE TABERNACLE) THE CIBORIUM WITH THE HOSTS IS KEPT ON THE CORPORAL. THE CIBORIUM'S COVER IS KEPT ON EXCEPT

OFFERING THE HOST, AND

2) WHEN THE PRIEST IS CONSECRATING THE HOST.

THE PRIEST NOW OFFERS BOTH THE HOST ON THE PATEN AND THE HOSTS IN THE CIBORIUM AS ONE.

HAVING OFFERED THE HOST, THE PRIEST PUTS THE PATEN ASIDE AND TAKES UP THE CHALICE, CLEANING IT WITH THE PURIFICATOR THEN HE PUTS WINE INTO THE CHALICE AND ADDS A DROP OR TWO OF WATER.

THE WINE STANDS FOR CHRIST. (IT WILL REALLY BECOME THE BLOOD OF CHRIST AT THE CONSECRATION.)



THE CHALICE IS KEPT COVERED WITH THE PALL SO THAT NOTHING CAN FALL INTO IT BY ACCIDENT.



THE PRIEST BREAKS THE HOST IN ORDER THAT HE MAY PUT A SMALL PIECE IN THE CHALICE.








THEN, STRIKING HIS BREAST AND CALLING ON CHRIST, THE PRIEST ONCE MORE BEGS FOR PEACE.



THE SECOND PRAYER BEFORE HOLY COMMUNION IS FOR UNION WITH JESUS. WE WANT TO STAY CLOSE TO HIM BY OBEYING HIS COMMANDMENTS.

LET NOT THE PARTAKING OF THY BODY, O LORD JESUS CHRIST, WHICH I, ALL UNWORTHY, MAKE BOLD TO RECEIVE, TURN TO MY JUDGMENT AND CONDEMNATION, BUT BY REASON OF THY LOVING KINDNESS, MAY IT BE TO ME A SAFEGUARD OF BOTH SOUL AND BODY, AND AN EFFECTIVE REMEDY. THEY SHOULD NOT ALL RUSH UP AT ONCE.







WHEN THE PRIEST COMES TO YOU WITH HOLY COMMUNION:

- 1. OPEN YOUR MOUTH.

- 4. KNEEL STILL (LEAN AGAINST THE ALTAR RAIL).
- 5. DON'T PUT YOUR HANDS AGAINST YOUR CHIN (IF YOU ARE SMALL, PUT THEM BELOW THE ALTAR RAIL).
- 6. KEEP YOUR EYES DOWN (DON'T STARE UP AT THE PRIEST).
- 7. CLOSE YOUR MOUTH ONLY AFTER THE PRIEST HAS PUT THE HOST ON YOUR TONGUE (DON'T SNAP!).





THERE ARE FOUR OFFICIAL PRAYERS OF THANKSGIVING IN THE MASS ITSELF.

THE FIRST TWO ARE SAID WHILE THE PRIEST WASHES OUT THE CHALICE.



FIRST THE PRIEST TAKES A
LITTLE WINE INTO THE CHALICE
AND DRINKS THAT TO REMOVE
ANY DROPS OF THE PRECIOUS
BLOOD WHICH MIGHT REMAIN.
AS THE ALTAR BOY POURS THE
WINE, THE PRIEST SAYS THE
FIRST PRAYER.



THEN THE PRIEST TAKES WINE AND WATER, LETTING THEM RUN OVER THE TIPS OF HIS FINGERS IN CASE ANYTHING FROM THE HOST IS ON HIS FINGERS. AS HE DOES THIS HE SAYS THE SECOND PRAYER.

THESE PRAYERS TELL YOU HOW TO PRAY AFTER COMMUNION

- 1. ASK JESUS TO STAY WITH YOU.
- 2. ASK JESUS TO BLESS YOU.
- 3. ASK JESUS TO KEEP YOU FROM EVERY KIND OF SIN.



THE PRIEST WIPES HIS FINGERS AND THE CHALICE WITH THE PURIFICATOR.



THE PRIEST DRINKS THE ABLUTION.

HAVING WIPED OUT THE CHALICE AND COVERED IT, THE PRIEST GOES TO THE MISSAL TO READ THE THIRD AND FOURTH PRAYERS OF THANKSGIVING.

BOTH THESE PRAYERS CHANGE WITH THE FEAST.



THE FIRST IS KNOWN AS THE COMMUNION PRAYER. IT IS VERY SHORT AND REMINDS US OF THE OFFERTORY VERSE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MASS OF THE FAITHFUL.








THE COMMUNION PRAYER IS VERY OFTEN A VERSE FROM ONE OF THE PSALMS. IN THE EARLY YEARS OF THE CHURCH THE WHOLE PSALM USED TO BE SUNG AS THE PEOPLE WENT TO HOLY COMMUNION.





JESUS IS WITH YOU AFTER HOLY COMMUNION. YOUR HEART SHOULD BE SINGING. IF YOU ARE NOT REALLY HAPPY AFTER RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION, IT IS BECAUSE YOU DO NOT THINK OF JESUS AFTER YOU RECEIVE HIM.



THE FOURTH PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING AFTER COMMUNION IS CALLED THE POSTCOMMUNION.

SOMETIMES THIS IS A SINGLE PRAYER, SOMETIMES A SET OF PRAYERS. THE POSTCOM-MUNION CORRESPONDS TO THE COLLECT AND THE SECRET.

BECAUSE THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT OF THE PRAYERS OF THANKSGIVING, THE PRIEST GREETS US BEFORE IT SO THAT WE SHALL PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION. THEN HE SAYS THE POSTCOMMUNIONS WITH HANDS EXTENDED JUST AS HE SAID THE COLLECTS.

THE POSTCOMMUNIONS ARE THE OFFICIAL PRAYERS OF THANKSGIVING FOR HOLY COMMUNION ON BEHALF OF THE WHOLE CHURCH. THEY ARE ALWAYS ADDRESSED TO THE FATHER THROUGH THE SON IN UNION WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT.





(SOMETIMES THERE IS A SPECIAL LAST GOSPEL AND THE PRIEST HAS TO READ IT OUT OF THE MISSAL. WHEN THIS HAPPENS HE LEAVES THE BOOK OPEN AND THE ALTAR BOY KNOWS HE MUST BRING IT OVER TO THE GOSPEL SIDE OF THE ALTAR.)

THE LAST PART OF THE MASS IS MADE UP OF THREE ACTIONS:

- 2. WE ARE BLESSED SO THAT WE WILL BE ABLE TO FILL OUR ORDERS.
- WE ARE REMINDED OF WHAT GOD HAS TAUGHT US SO THAT WE SHALL KNOW HOW TO FUL-FILL OUR ORDERS.

FIRST THE PRIEST TURNS TO THE PEOPLE AND SAYS: "GO, YOU ARE SENT FORTH."

WE HAVE BEEN UNITED WITH JESUS ON THE CROSS. JESUS HAS COME TO US. NOW WE MUST TAKE JESUS TO THE WORLD:

-BY WORKING HARD,

-BY BEING KIND TO OTHERS,

- BY GIVING GOOD EXAMPLE, - BY DOING WHATEVER GOD

WANTS US TO DO.
WE KNOW WHAT WE MUST DO. SO

STAND FOR THE LAST GOSPEL



AFTER BLESSING US THE PRIEST DOES WHAT SEEMS TO BE A VERY STRANGE THING. HE GOES TO THE GOSPEL SIDE OF THE ALTAR AND READS THE LAST GOSPEL. SOMETIMES THIS IS A SPECIAL GOSPEL, BUT USUALLY IT IS THE SAME PASSAGE FROM THE VERY BEGINNING OF THE GOSPEL OF SAINT JOHN.

WHY DOES THE PRIEST DO THIS AT THE VERY END OF THE MASS?

HE DOES IT TO REMIND US OF THE INSTRUCTIONS WE RECEIVED IN THE MASS OF THE CATECHUMENS. IF WE ARE GOING TO BRING JESUS TO THE WORLD WE MUST REMEMBER THOSE INSTRUCTIONS.







AGAIN WE SIGN OURSELVES WITH THE SIGN OF THE CROSS AS THE GOSPEL BEGINS.

WE ASK GOD TO BE IN OUR MIND AND HEART AND ON OUR LIPS.




